The feast of the most holy Body and Blood of Christ is the solemn commemoration of the institution of the Eucharist and is the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ, who by instituting this sacrament gave us our greatest treasure - the food of eternal life.

The liturgy for Corpus Christi was edited or composed by St Thomas Aquinas OP at the request of Pope Urban IV in 1264 and it is recognised as an exceptionally fine piece of liturgical work in the best tradition.
